How to Travel to Posadas

Via Buenos Aires – Daily flights during the week to Posadas via Aerolíneas Argentinas <https://www.aerolineas.com.ar/> from Jorge Newbery (Aeroparque) Airport in Buenos Aires with the following schedules:

From Buenos Aires 8:35 am Arrival at Posadas 10:00 am
From Buenos Aires 12:40 pm Arrival at Posadas 14:25 pm
From Buenos Aires 18:55 pm Arrival at Posadas 20:30 pm

Return to Buenos Aires, weekdays

From Posadas 10:40 am Arriving at Buenos Aires 12:15 pm
From Posadas 16:30 am Arriving at Buenos Aires 18:00 pm
From Posadas 21:15 am Arriving at Buenos Aires 22:50 pm

Additional options exist to connect via Foz de Iguacu (Brasil) or Puerto Iguazu (Argentina), that members may want to consider including days for enjoying visiting the famous Iguazu falls.
